CLIENT SERVICES AVAILABLE

- ◆ SHELTER: including meals provided by the shelter, private bedrooms, in a relaxed and <u>safe</u> family-oriented environment
- ♦ IN-HOUSE ADVOCACY: includes crisis intervention groups to meet the victim's needs, individual healing sessions, safety planning, legal assistance, resource referrals, employment opportunities, housing opportunities, and other situational circumstances
- ◆ OUTREACH: includes confidential meeting location outside of the shelter, crisis intervention groups to meet the victim's needs, individual healing sessions, safety planning, legal assistance, resource referrals, employment opportunities, housing

opportunities, and other situational circumstances

- ♦ DOMESTIC VIOLENCE/SEXUAL ASSAULT GROUPS: Patterns of Abuse, Define Abuse, Emotional Abuse, Cycle of
 Violence, Anger Management, SelfEsteem, Identifying a Batterer, Budgeting, Life Skills (cooking, cleaning, etc.),
 Parenting, Organization, Depression, Divorce, Stress, Power/
 Control, Co-Dependency, Etc.
- ♦ LEGAL ASSISTANCE: protective orders, no-contact orders, divorce, child support, child custody, paternity, and other situational circumstances.
- ◆ PUBLIC EDUCATION: community awareness, school-wide (all ages) lessons on domestic violence, self-esteem, anti-
